

JAMES LOGAN HIGH SCHOOL SPECTATOR POLICY

(Approved 3/23/21)

This spectator policy was presented to Ron Polk. (JLHS Principal) and Dr. John Thompson (NHUSD Superintendent) for review and approval of a modified spectator policy for all James Logan High School athletic events for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. **This policy may differ with all of the other member schools of the MVAL, WACC, and NCS. Spectators are asked to follow other member school's policy.** Brief details of the policy are listed below:

THIS SPECTATOR POLICY GOES INTO EFFECT ON TUESDAY, MARCH 23, 2021. (updated 4/22/21)

- Based on CDPH and Alameda County guidelines, James Logan High School will allow immediate household members, determined by the maximum number allowed per sport in the chart below and based on the school's facility specifications, to attend athletic events for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. Spectators must follow the school's protocols for entry into the contest. Spectators are limited to ensure physical distance can be maintained, reduce potential crowding, and outdoor capacity limits.
- **Indoor spectators are not permitted** at this time as it must follow the Institution of Higher Education (IHE) guidelines. *Athletic facilities must therefore limit occupancy to essential personnel, such as players, coaches, trainers, security, and event staff. The California Department of Public Health, in consultation with local departments of public health, will review and assess the impact of these imposed limits on public health and provide further direction as part of a phased-in restoration of leisure activities.*

SPECTATORS MUST NOT ATTEND THE CONTEST IF EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE COVID SYMPTOMS (as mentioned by the CDPH), OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED OR IN CONTACT WITH A COVID-19 POSITIVE PERSON IN THE LAST 14 DAYS.

FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY ALL SPECTATORS AT ALL TIMES.

- Spectators must be at least **18 years of age and older per CDPH guideline. If bringing a child, they must be of immediate family and must sit with the family in the stands at all times.**
- If a spectator is asked to leave a contest due to poor sportsmanship, not adhering to the CDPH guidelines, and/or not adhering to host school guidelines, that spectator will not be allowed to attend any James Logan contest (home or away) for the remainder of the 2021 season.
- All spectators will be required to present their student-athlete's name at the entrance for verification from a player roster. **ALL FAMILY MEMBERS** are requested to enter at the same time to avoid confusion.
- Each group must sit socially distanced at least 6 feet apart from other family groups.
- There are no in and out privileges and spectators are expected to sit in the stands and not walk around the stadium facility
- Bathroom use will be limited to one person at a time.
- Spectators must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
- MVAL prices for entry will be in effect. Adults-\$7, Students (18 yo+)-\$5
